




## **AUTOMATED GARBAGE COLLECTION**

Your City issued garbage cart will be emptied by City contractor Republic Services using a fully-automated one person garbage truck. From the truck cab the driver will operate the truck's mechanical arm to grasp, empty and place your cart back in its original position. Therefore, the driver does not get out of the truck. To assure your cart receives uninterrupted collection without damage to your cart or property, please follow these simple directions.

- **On collection day place cart at curb by 7:00 a.m. and remove by 7:30 p.m. Do not place cart in the street or driveway.**
- **Place your City issued cart at the curb with the cart's front facing the street with the handle and wheels side toward your house.**
- **On collection day do not block cart with vehicles on street.**
- **Place the cart well away from fixed objects such as mail boxes, poles, hydrants, shrubbery, wires and other items such as your recycling bin and yard debris bags etc. *Approximately 6 to 8 feet of space on both sides of the cart is requested to allow ample room for the automated truck to operate; however, if you do not have 6 to 8 feet of room on each side, place your cart midway between the objects.***
- **See opposite side of this flyer for visual examples of cart placement.**
- **Do not place anything in front of your cart or on top of your cart.**
- **Recycling bins are not serviced by an automated truck.**



**WRONG**




**INCORRECT** placement. Cart turned wrong. Handle and wheel side should be facing the house.
