Invitation for Bid [IFB] Construction Services for Upgrades to Memphis Housing Authority High Rises & Boiler Replacement, Memphis, TN Solicitation # CI 14-B-00290

The Memphis Housing Authority (MHA) is soliciting Firm Fixed Price bids from highly qualified contractors to provide construction services for the Authority Wide/ High Rise Boiler Replacement at Memphis Housing Authority High Rises, Memphis, TN. The project includes, but is not limited, removal of existing boilers, installation of new distribution lines, construction of storage facility, and selective demolition at Edward Barry Towers, Paul Borda Towers, and Venson Center, all located in Memphis, TN.

The Invitation for Bid [IFB] package will be available, at a non-refundable cost of **fifty dollars [\$50.00]** beginning **Tuesday, March 11, 2014**. **Those bidders who previously obtained a bid package and choose to retrieve a new one will not be charged an additional fee.** The IFB can be obtained from the office of Capital Improvements Department at the Memphis Housing Authority [MHA] office, located at 700 Adams Avenue, Room 107, Memphis, TN 38105-5029. The IFB package may also be secured by regular mail or FedEx, UPS or USPS [at the requestor's expense] by submitting a written request and non-refundable **\$50.00 payment** to Memphis Housing Authority. The method of payment shall be cashier's check, company checks or money order; no personal checks will be accepted. A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on **Wednesday, March 19, 2014 at 2:00 p.m.** at 700 Adams Avenue, in the Asset Management Conference Room on the first floor.
