Several Juveniles Receive Juvenile Summons South Bellevue//Peabody

MEMPHIS, September 29, 2014- On Friday, September 26, 2014 at approximately 10:00pm, officers responded to a Vandalism/Assault in the area of South Bellevue and Peabody.

Officers were advised by Victim #1, **male, 51**, and Victim #2, **female, 26**, while in the area of S Bellevue and Peabody they witnessed a large group of juveniles who were congregated in the roadway. One of the victims attempted to clear the area by blowing his car horn at which time the juveniles began kicking the victim's vehicle. Victim #2 drove through the same area and also received damage to her vehicle due to the juveniles kicking her vehicle. Officers arrived in the area and detained several suspects. Two juveniles, **males, 17**, were issued a juvenile summons for Vandalism \$500.00 or Less.

At approximately the same time as the aforementioned incident occurred, an assault took place involving a **16-year-old male** victim. The victim was reportedly leaving the Central High School football game when he was struck in the face by a male suspect. While the victim was talking to the officers about this incident, it was determined that the suspect responsible for the assault was already detained due to the vandalism. The suspect, **male, 17**, was identified and issued a juvenile summons for Assault.

At approximately 11:00pm, officers received an additional call to the area of Peabody and South Bellevue where they located a **55-year-old male** victim who had been assaulted by several males. The victim advised that the suspects struck him several times causing injury to his head. The victim was unable to provide any description as to who was responsible other than there were 5 – 6 male Blacks.

Thus far, in totality, there have been three juvenile summons issued. These investigations are ongoing.

“Several juvenile summonses were issued by MPD in connection with these incidents; however, these investigations are ongoing. Due to these incidents occurring after a high school football game, I will be reaching out to the Shelby County Sheriff’s Office and the Shelby County School District to ensure these school events have adequate law enforcement present, said Director Toney Armstrong. “It is also imperative that parents and guardians become more engaged in their children’s day to day activities. Parental supervision is crucial to reducing delinquent behavior; we have got to get our parents more involved with what is going on in the lives of our children.”



 Narrative/Case Notes (1)

On 09/26/2014 at 21:50 hours, Crump Station Delta Shift Task Force officers C Leatherwood (11329), R Palmer (12816), J Blessick (10561) and C Beaty (6842) responded to a Vandalism/Misdemeanor at S Bellevue//Peabody. Officer Palmer was flagged down by both victim [REDACTED] and victim [REDACTED] at S Bellevue and Peabody where there was a large group of teenagers congregating in the immediate area who vandalized their vehicles. Victim [REDACTED] advised that he was N/B on S Bellevue approaching Peabody when he had to stop for a large group of teenagers blocking the street. Victim [REDACTED] advised the group would not move and he began to honk his horn in an effort to make the move out of the street. At that time, victim [REDACTED] advised several of the teenagers began kicking his car causing damage to his vehicle. Victim [REDACTED] advised he was able to drive away and flag down officer Palmer. R/O observed multiple dents in the rear left and rear right doors of the victim's white 2007 Chrysler Sebring. Victim Sharon Mounin advised she was also traveling on S Bellevue when she had to stop for the same large group of teenagers. Victim Sharon Mounin advised that the same group of teenagers began kicking her car as well causing a large dent to the right rear quarter panel of her silver 2009 Chrysler Sebring. R/O did observe a dent in the right rear quarter panel of the victim's vehicle. Officers Blessick, Beaty and Leatherwood responded to the scene to assist. Both victim's pointed at a group of approximately ten individuals who were in the group that was kicking their vehicles. Officers detained these individuals for further investigation. Victim [REDACTED] advised he was unsure who actually kicked his vehicle. Victim Sharon Mounin and her daughter, witness [REDACTED] (front passenger), identified suspect [REDACTED] suspect [REDACTED] Green, suspect [REDACTED] Henry and suspect [REDACTED] as the ones responsible for kicking and damaging the victim's vehicle. The damage to both vehicles was approximated at \$150.00 each. Suspect [REDACTED] and suspect [REDACTED] are both juveniles and were issued juvenile summons for vandalism on the scene and released. Suspect [REDACTED] Green and suspect [REDACTED] Henry were released pending further investigation. R/O took photos of the damages to both vehicles.



On 09/26/2014 at 21:50 hours, Taskforce Officers Palmer (12816) Blessike (10651) Beaty (6842) and Leatherwood (11329) and responded to a Simple Assault at Bellevue And Peabody. Complainant [Redacted] advised that her son victim [Redacted] was struck in the face by a group of juveniles leaving the Central High School football game. Victim [Redacted] advised that he was struck one time in the face by a male by the name of [Redacted] with a closed fist and described what the male named [Redacted] was wearing. (khaki shorts pink hoodie with

a horse on the chest) Victim advised that he did not loose consciousness after the strike but was kicked as he attempted to get up. Victim also advised that nothing was taken during the incident. Ofcs had a group of juveniles detained in relation to several vandalism's in the area. Ofcs observed a subject in the group matching the description victim provided. That individual was detained and identified as suspec Suspect was issued a juvenile summons and released on the scene. Victim did not have any injuries or require any medical treatment.(victim mother complainant agreed) Complainant was advised and left the scene with victim




Narrative/Case Notes (1)
