#### Q&A Clarification and Due Date Extension

The Due Date for RFP #28043 is hereby extended to October 21, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. CST.

3	Q		Please clarify whether the 5% of the material which is not to be transported to the new location will be measured for pay at the same rate as the transported material, or if this material is not measured for pay. (The Answer to this question in Addendum 1 has been revised based on new information, which is below)
3	A		The estimated five (5) percent of debris, which the contractor would be required to segregate and remove from the biosolids, would not be measured for pay. The contractor would be required to provide roll-off bins or dump trucks to load the debris into and transport the debris to City-designated landfills for disposal. Debris segregated from the biosolids at the MC Stiles WWTF would be disposed of at the Republic Services North Shelby Landfill, which is located at 7111 Old Millington Road, Millington, TN 38053, Phone # (901)872-7258. Debris segregated from biosolids at the TE Maxson WWTF would be disposed of at the Republic Services South Shelby Landfill, which is located at 5494 Malone Road, Memphis, TN 38118, Phone # (901)794-8071. The contractor would not include the tipping fees in their costs because Republic Services will invoice the City directly for the tipping fees for the segregated debris disposal.
			<b>Additional Question</b>
	Q		There were concerns regarding Fleeting Rights to park barges along the Mississippi River bank next to the MC Stiles WWTF lagoons.
	A		There are no Fleeting Rights associated with the Mississippi River banks next to the MC Stiles WWTF lagoons. Therefore, the winning contractor can park barges along that area, but would need to work with other local businesses that park their barges along that area.
