

# MEMPHIS SKATE PARK

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Skate Park is **UNSUPERVISED. SKATE AT YOUR OWN RISK.**
2. **All participants must wear a helmet.** Know your abilities and skate within them.
3. **Park hours are: 6 AM to 8 PM from March 15-October 31  
6 AM to 6 PM from November 1 – March 14;**  
No loitering after park is closed.
4. **Skaters are allowed Tuesday through Sunday, with Bike use in this park allowed only on Mondays.**
5. Do not skate if the surface is wet or icy.
6. **Participants under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or adult and wear all protective gear: helmet, knee and elbow pads.**
7. It is strongly recommended that adult users wear knee and elbow pads.
8. Spectators and non-participants must remain outside of the concrete skate areas.
9. Glass containers, pets, weapons, drugs, alcohol and smoking are prohibited with-in the fenced skate park area.
10. Acts of vandalism will not be tolerated and will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.
11. Reckless or aggressive behavior, fighting, profanity or offensive language will not be tolerated.
12. Loud music, televisions, DVD players, headphones and amplified sounds are prohibited.
13. Personal obstacles, ramps, and other equipment or materials are not permitted to be used or added to the park. Park structures are not to be altered or waxed.
14. Absolutely no “snaking” and skating against the traffic on ramps or pipes.
15. Organized events or contest are not allowed in the park unless first approved by the Division of Park Services.
