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- I. Call to Order** – The regular scheduled meeting of the Memphis Transportation Board was called to order by Sgt-At-Arms Officer Gerald Lake at 1:44 p.m.
- II. Roll Call** – The following Commissioners were present: Vincent Higgins, Tawanda Knight, Richard White, Lisa Gleaves, and Jeffery Harris. Scott Boucher and Kevin Kane were absent.
- III. Approval of Minutes of the Previous Meeting** – The minutes of the previous meeting were distributed prior to the meeting. **Commissioner White moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Harris second. The motion passed.**
- IV. Application for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity**
1. John W. Love- SLS, LLC – 1155 Airways – “**SLS Transportation**”
SLS Transportation was represented by the proposed managing partner, John Love and business manager, Chris Boyd. The Commissioners asked where the proposed business would come from and how many vehicles did the company currently have. Mr. Boyd stated that some of the business would come from the funeral home adjacent to their business and that they had 5 cars. Commissioner Higgins asked about the other members of the LLC. Mr. Love stated that the other members were his wife and daughter. **Commissioner Gleaves motion to approve the location pending a background check being done on the remainder partners of the LLC and the registration transferred into SLS, LLC.
