I have lived in Memphis from 1943 until the present time. I graduated from Christian Brothers High School in 1957, attended Purdue University and graduated from Christian Brothers University in 1962 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering.

Thompson Engineers, Inc. was founded by my father, William B. Thompson, Sr. in 1949. I began working there as a draftsman in 1955 while in high school and worked as a plumbing and HVAC designer while attending college. I am presently chief plumbing and fire protection design engineer for Thompson Engineers, Inc. and have worked there for fifty years.


