



2013 SUMMER CAMP JUNE 10 – JULY 26, 2013



The Division of Parks and Neighborhoods offers a Summer Day Camp (ages 5 to 12) at all of its 24 Community Centers and a Summer Teen Camp (ages 13 to 15) at selected sites. Campers will participate in recreational, athletic, cultural and educational activities, Citywide Summer Camp Track and Field Competition as well as attend field trips. Athletic Programs such as Soccer, Tennis, Basketball and Softball are also offered. A Summer Day Camp is also offered at the Skinner Development Center for participants with special needs.

Early Registration – Saturday, April 13, 2013 9:00 am – 12 pm

Option 1: Total fees paid guarantees summer camp slot.

Full fee - \$162.00 regular rate; \$81.00 discount rate for families on verified government assistance; (Must provide proof via Food Stamps, AFDC, Social Security or Disability for Child); Non-resident fee \$324.00 regular rate. Early Arrival - Basic rate of \$35.00 for one child/\$55.00 for 2 or more children.

Option 2: One-half (1/2) of total fees paid reserves camp slot for 30 days. Balance Due on partial pays by May 11, 2013 (Regular Registration date)

Regular Registration – Saturday, May 11, 2013 9:00 am- 12 pm

Option 1: First time registrants pay full fees at this time.

Option 2: Registrants pay balance due (of 1/2) from April 13, 2013 Early Registration process Slot guaranteed at specific registration site.

Option 3: Registrants can elect to pay 1/2 of total fees due. Balance Due June 8, 2013 (pending slot availability)

Final Registration - Saturday, June 8, 2013 9:00 am – 12 pm

Only Option: Full payment of any fees; no partial payments will be accepted during this period.

Where: Any center which has not reached its capacity during Early and Regular Registration dates.

Summer Camp at a Glance

- All fees must be remitted by money order or cashier's check only.
- No cash, credit cards or personal checks will be accepted.
- Regular operational hours are 8:30 AM until 4:30 PM each day
- Lunch and a snack will be provided free of charge each day
- Monday through Friday except for recognized holidays (4th of July in observance of Independence Day).

DOCUMENTS NEEDED

Only Parents/Guardians can register campers and must provide a Driver's License or State ID for themselves along with a birth certificate for the camper.

Additionally, Legal Guardian documentation must be provided.

Proof of Residency must be supported by 2 of the following documents in order to receive the regular rate:

- City of Memphis Tax Bill
- Current Utility Bill (within 30 days)
- Current Bank Statement (within 30 days)
