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Police Recruitment Hiring Process

MEMPHIS, TN- Mayor Willie W. Herenton is committed to increasing the complement of police officers in the City of Memphis with capable and qualified individuals who possess the drive to serve our community. Individuals interested in serving our community in the capacity of police officer are invited to submit an application to the Human Resources Division. This invitation is also extended to persons who may not have been successful in previous years with their police application.

Applicants will undergo the following testing:

- Running Test (1.5 miles within 15 minutes or less)
- Entry Testing (such as Reading Test, Entry Level Police Test, Problem Solving Assessments)
- Physical Agility Test
- Background Review/Assessment
- Psychological Assessment
- Medical Assessment

When applicants are scheduled for testing, written notice will be provided advising the candidate of their particular test dates. Candidates are not selected on a first come first serve basis. Police Recruit classes will be filled as needed based on the candidates' performance during testing.
