

RESOLUTION TO CLARIFY THE LANGUAGE OF THE RESOLUTION TO EXEMPT CERTAIN CITY OF MEMPHIS POLICE OFFICERS FROM RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT WHOSE DUTIES REQUIRE THEM TO PERFORM SERVICES ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OUTSIDE OF THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MEMPHIS AND ALLOWING CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS TO RESIDE NO GREATER THAN 20 MILES OUTSIDE THE BOUNDARIES OF SHELBY COUNTY, TENNESSEE UPON PAYMENT OF ANNUAL FEE

WHEREAS, the Memphis City Council approved a resolution on January 27, 2009, (attached) containing a provision stipulating that “no more than 10% of the desired complement of officers needed can be hired from twenty miles outside the boundary of Shelby County”; and

WHEREAS, the language above must be clarified so as to alleviate any misunderstanding as to the Council’s desired intent relative to those officers who reside and are hired from twenty miles outside the boundary of Shelby County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMPHIS CITY COUNCIL that the language “can be hired from” shall be deleted and replaced with “are allowed to reside”. All other provisions and the effectiveness thereof remain.
