Black & Veatch and Overland Contracting (a subsidiary of Black & Veatch), as the Program Manager and Construction Manager for the Wastewater Collection and Transmission System (WCTS) Assessment and Rehabilitation Program on behalf of the City of Memphis, is soliciting Request for Bid (RFB) for the rehabilitation of the Grey's Creek Big Orange Lift Station.

This Work consists of the rehabilitation of the Grey's Creek Big Orange Lift Station. The Work generally involves the demolition of existing valves, valve pits, and force mains; the replacement of electrical conduits and wiring, wet well piping, and pump guide rails; and the construction of an underground concrete valve vault with new force main piping and valves. This RFB entails site work such as grading, erosion control, reseeding, and temporary barriers. Subcontractor will provide and maintain adequate bypass pumping during the Work. The Subcontractor shall also recondition the wet well and remove and properly dispose of solids and debris from the wet well. The contract will be awarded based on full scope of Work; partial RFB's will not be accepted.

The recommended Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) goal is twenty eight percent (28%) and the Women Business Enterprise (WBE) is four percent (4%) for a combined M/WBE goal of thirty two percent (32%).
