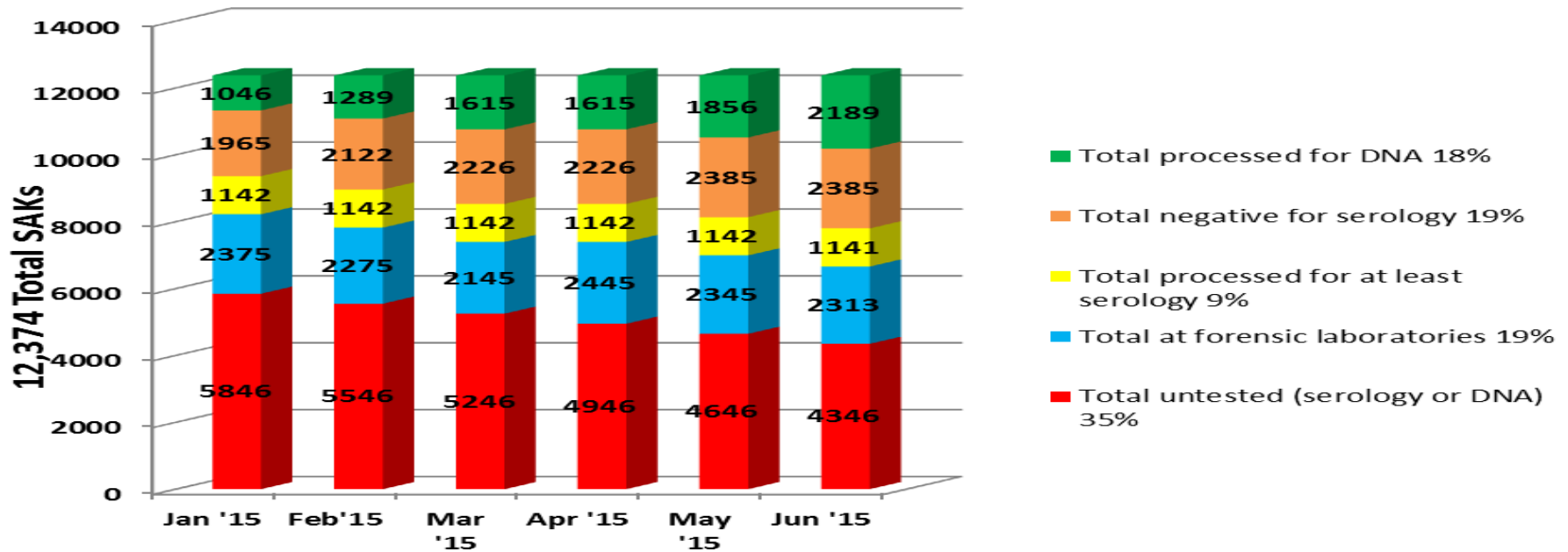

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Investigation Results

As a result of DNA analysis
(Cumulative Last Month/This Month)

566/614 investigations have been initiated:

163/163 investigations remain active: 27%

403/451 investigations are closed: 73%

68/76 individuals were identified that had been previously convicted of the crime: 17%

98/105 Requests for indictments have been completed against persons or DNA profiles: 23%

- 58/64 named suspects (27 multi case suspects) 61% of indictments
- 40/41 John Does (2 suspects on one case) 39% of indictments
 - 11/12 John Does are now named (7 multi case suspects) 29% of John Does
 - 1 John Doe is deceased

44/51 victims/suspects are deceased: 11%

- 7/9 suspects (does not include the deceased John Doe) 2%
- 37/42 victims: 9%

57/67 victims declined to participate: 15%

13/17 unable to locate victim: 4%

79/85 cases past the statute of limitations: 19%

0/0 prosecution declined: 0%

23/25 insufficient/degraded DNA: 6%

6/9 cases no crime occurred: 2%

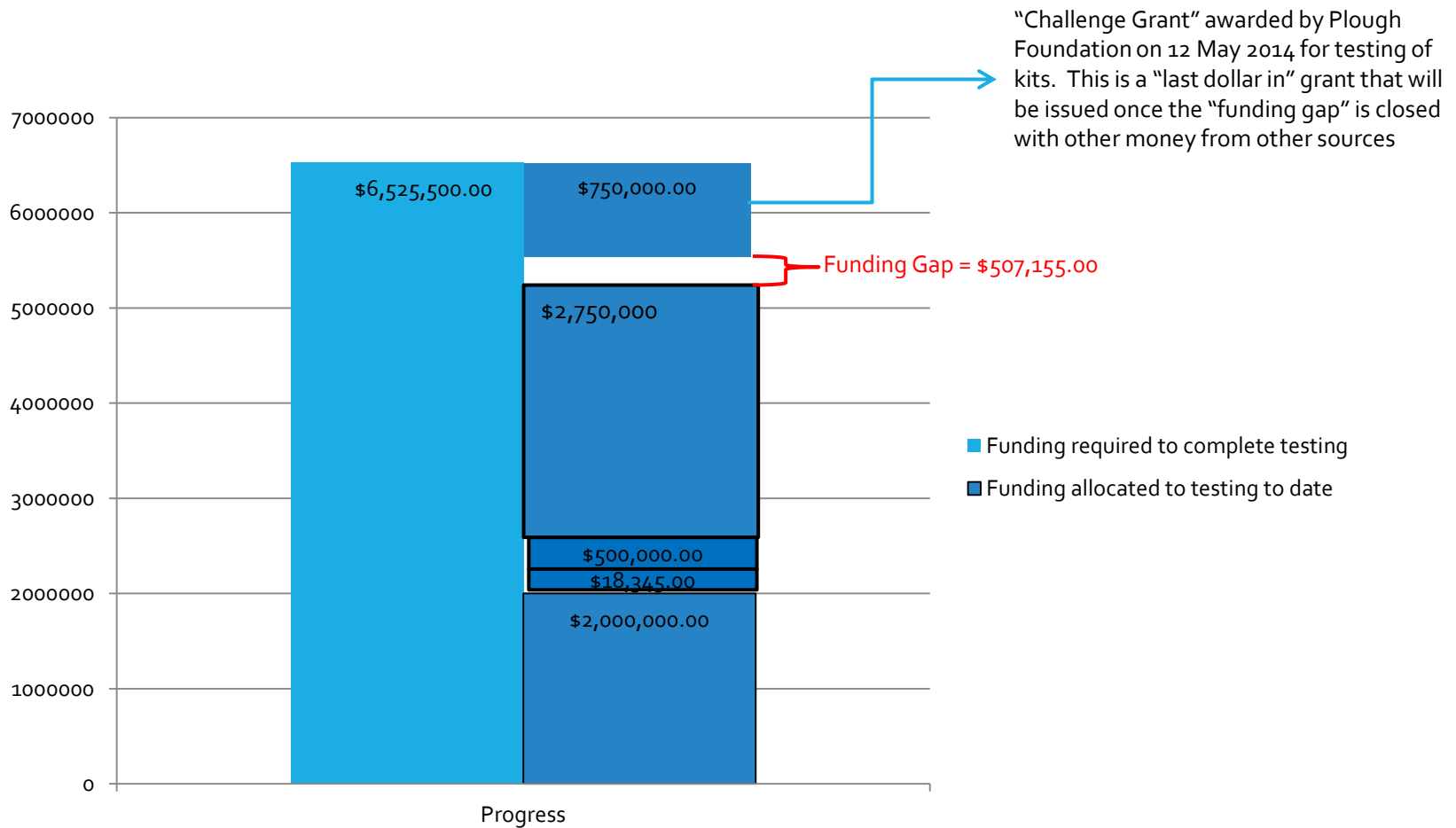
