Memphis Animal Services Offers Holiday Adoption Special

\$31 Through the 31st Adoption Special to start Dec. 20



Memphis, Tenn., Dec. 19, 2016 – Memphis Animal Services will offer **\$31 Through the 31st**, a special adoption campaign in which adoption fees will be reduced to \$31 for all adoptable pets, from Tuesday, Dec. 20, until Saturday, Dec. 31.

The \$31 adoption fee is a reduction from the regular \$75 for dogs and \$70 for cats. As always, included in the adoption fee is spay/neuter, vaccinations, microchip, collar and leash, and a customized ID tag.

“We hope that Memphians will consider making spirits bright for a homeless dog or cat this holiday season,” said Alexis Pugh, administrator of Memphis Animal Services. “We would love to give every adoptable pet in our shelter the gift of a home for the holidays.”
