Elderly or Disabled Homeowner(s) and their spouses must:

- **Complete the front and back of all application(s) and sign all forms.**
- **Submit a copy of all 2022 income, including 1099 Social Security Benefit Statement and 2022 Income Tax Return (if filed).**

Disabled Veteran or Widow(er) of Disabled Veteran must sign and return the enclosed 2023 Application Credit Voucher.

New Applicant(s)

Elderly or Disabled Homeowners applying for Tax Relief and/or Tax Freeze must fill out all application(s), submit a copy of all 2022 income and a copy of your current driver license with your application(s).

Disabled Veteran or Widow(er) of Disabled Veteran applying for Tax Relief must fill out the enclosed forms and submit a copy of current driver license.

If you have a portion of taxes to pay, see your City of Memphis Tax Bill for the “Total Amount Due” and submit with your application(s).

If your taxes are paid by your mortgage company, write in the comment section, (Mortgage Company pays taxes).
