

**MINUTES OF
THE RETIREMENT AND PENSION BOARD SYSTEM**

The Board of Administration of the Pension and Retirement System of the City of Memphis met in 4th floor Conference Room A, Thursday, May 28, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. The following members responded to roll call:

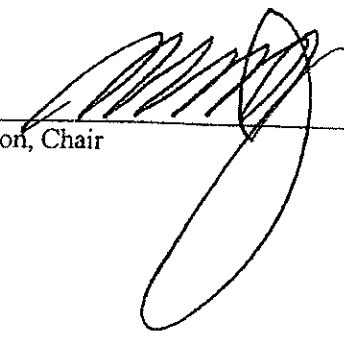
