One such resource is the City of Memphis Division of Housing and Community Development's Renaissance Business Center.

The Renaissance Business Center (RBC) is the "Best Kept Secret in Memphis". Located at 555 Beale Street, the RBC is a One-Stop-Shop business development and resource center for entrepreneurs and small business owners. The RBC offers seminars, training sessions and workshops covering various topics including: How to Start a Business, Developing a Business Plan, QuickBooks, Social Media Marketing and much more. In addition, the RBC provides professional counselors who have the expertise to understand the needs of small businesses and to provide solutions.

Surprisingly, many of the services at the RBC are FREE. However, "free" does not compromise its quality. Because of its one-stop-shop design, small business owners have access to resource providers who can offer services ranging from research and business planning assistance to direct access to capital.

The resource providers located at the RBC are the Black Business Association (BBA), Memphis Area Minority Contractors Association (MAMCA), Small Business Administration (SBA) and the Tennessee Small Business Development Center (TSBDC). They all work together with the RBC to deliver innovative programs that strengthen and support business enterprises in an environment that exceeds expectations.

Starting Your Business involves planning, making key financial decisions and completing a series of legal activities. These 10 easy steps can help you plan, prepare and manage your business:

Step 1:

Write a Business Plan

A business plan is a written guide that will assist you in mapping out how you will start and operate your business successfully.

Step 2:

Get Business Assistance and Training

Take advantage of free training and counseling services, from preparing a business plan and securing financing, to expanding or relocating a business.

Step 3:

Choose a Business Location

Get advice on how to select a customer-friendly location and comply with zoning laws.

Step 4:

Finance Your Business

Find government backed loans, venture capital and research grants to help you get started.

Step 5:

Determine the Legal Structure of Your Business

Decide which form of business ownership is best for you: Sole Proprietorship, partnership, corporation, S corporation, nonprofit or cooperative.

Step 6:

Register a Business Name ("Doing Business As")

Take steps to register your business name with your state government.

Step 7:

Get a Tax Identification Number

Learn which tax ID number you'll need to obtain from the IRS and your state revenue agency.

Step 8:

Register for State and Local Taxes

Register with your state to obtain a tax identification number, unemployment and disability insurance as well as workers' compensation.

Step 9:

Obtain Business Licenses and Permits

Obtain a list of federal, state and local licenses and permits required for your business.

Step 10:

Understand Employer Responsibilities

Learn the legal steps you need to take to hire employees.
