


Aggravated Assault by Month

*UCR 13A AGGRAVATED ASSAULT/09A Murder


Interstate Shootings YTD

Interstate Shootings by Year








Third Quarter 2023 Auto Theft by Age: Juvenile & 18/19/20

Chop Shop Arrests









*Ongoing investigation- several incidents related to chop shops have yielded arrests with recovered property

• Auto Theft Task Force officers responded to a chop shop complaint and after executing a search warrant, several stolen vehicles, stolen firearms, and drugs were recovered. Johnnie Davis, Fatina Hewitt, and Javon McKinney were arrested and charged.



 The Multi-Agency Gang Unit served a search warrant regarding a drug investigation and apprehended Justin Blue and Dantrell Royal in possession of various narcotics, ammunitions, handguns, and currency. Justin Blue is also responsible for various auto thefts and theft from motor vehicle incidents throughout the city, along with two shootings where one incident was fatal.



Dantrell Royal, 20, was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance with the Intent to Manufacture/Deliver/Sell of Marijuana, Possession of a Firearm During the Commission /Attempt to Commit a Dangerous Felony, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Prohibited Weapons, Possession of a Controlled Substance of Promethazine. Royal is out on a \$5,000 bond.




Justin Blue, 18, has been charged with First Degree Murder, Aggravated Assault (4X), Vandalism \$1,000-\$2,500, Reckless Endangerment with a Deadly Weapon, Unlawful Possession of a Weapon, Theft of Property \$10,000-\$60,000, Auto Burglary (17X), Theft of Property \$1,000 or less (7X), and Violation of Probation.



On August 17th, 2023, four men drove a truck through the front doors at Buster's Liquors. Once inside, the men loaded the bed of the pickup truck with liquor bottles. One of the men, Malik Pigram, was seen fleeing the scene on foot. As he crossed Highland, he was struck by a passing motorist. Officers soon located Pigram hiding under a nearby vehicle and took him into custody. Pigram was armed with a loaded 9mm handgun at the time of his arrest.

Pigram, who has previously been convicted of Attempted Carjacking, was charged with **Burglary of a Business** and **Convicted Felon in Possession of a Handgun**.



On August 31st, 2023, a man was approached by an armed suspect as he walked out of a business on South Third. The suspect, later identified as Davonte Vortis, demanded the victim's keys, then fled in the victim's car. Approximately 40 minutes later, Vortis entered another business and robbed the clerk at gunpoint.

Responding officers spotted Vortis as he fled the second robbery in the carjacked vehicle. Although Vortis attempted to elude officers, the car soon broke down and he was captured. He was armed with a gold 9mm handgun at the time of his arrest.

Vortis was charged with **Carjacking**, **Aggravated Robbery**, **Employment of a Firearm during a Dangerous Felony**, and **Intentionally Evading Arrest in an Automobile**.



On September 7th, 2023, a man was shot while attending a concert at the FedEx Forum. During the subsequent investigation, investigators discovered that the shooter was attempting to shoot a third man but struck the victim by mistake. The intended victim provided investigators with information that led to the identification of Kevin Young. Investigators were able to positively identify Young, a known gang member, through additional cell phone video of the incident.

Young, who was already out on bond on a slew of felony charges including First Degree Murder, was indicted for **Reckless Endangerment with a Deadly Weapon** and **Unlawful Possession of a Weapon**. When officers served the warrant, Young was found with six handguns, three AR-15 rifles, and over 400 grams of marijuana.




