## MEMPHIS AMBASSADORS PROGRAM 9th –12th (MAP) Overview

The Memphis Ambassadors Program provides year-round after-school developmental and enrichment opportunities for between 400 and 500 youth in each of Memphis' city council districts. MAP is upheld by the Five Pillars: Leadership, Education, Entrepreneurship, Community Service, and Perseverance, and engages youth in grades 8th-12th. MAP guides youth in their decision-making process about post-secondary life.

The program focuses on professional development, social justice, mental health and wellness curriculums, and community service, and donations to low-income areas. The goal is to help youth in Memphis develop holistically and provide them with mentors to guide them in their growth and development journey.

## ALL MY CHILDREN (AMC) Overview

The All My Children Program is a year-round enrichment program that falls under the umbrella of The Memphis Ambassadors Program (MAP). AMC aims to work with youth who are in transition and are experiencing unfortunate life challenges. The objective is to provide holistic support for Memphis youth to purposefully pursue high-quality lifestyles that will enhance them and their communities.

All My Children (AMC) is open to students from all backgrounds and socioeconomic levels. It is our goal to provide equitable instruction and mentorship. AMC aims to create an environment in which young people are empowered, valued, guided, and taught leadership skills, which contribute directly to their selfconfidence and personal growth.

THE MEMPHIS AMBASSADORS APPRENTICE PROGRAM (MAAP) is a year-round enrichment program for underperforming 8th grade students. The program serves as an educational component, of the **Memphis Ambassadors Program**. Our mission is to raise student GPAs to 3.0. The program reinforces 7th-grade foundational skills and 8th-grade concepts.

The program's goal is to build a strong educational foundation through tutoring and mentoring which aims to create an environment where students can take an active role in their educational experience and develop self-esteem and self-confidence in and outside of the classroom.

# The Memphis Ambassadors Program ASK for MAP 9th-12th, AMC, & MAAP

### Cost per Ambassador for Programming

- Increase Misc. Professional Services line by \$100,000
- Cost per Ambassador Stipend for additional 320 youth
  - Increase Ambassador's Fellowship pay line by **\$2,925,000**
- Cost for seventeen additional part-time staff
  - Increase Part-time Salaries line by **\$500,000**
- ► Three Full-Time Leads
  - Increase Full-time Salaries line by \$135,000
